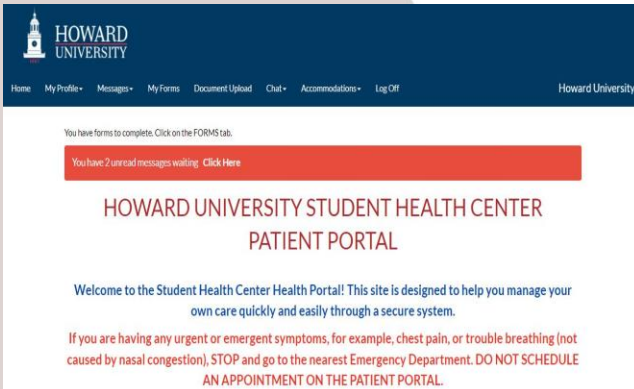
The Howard University Student Health Center provides comprehensive high-quality healthcare to all current and full-time and part-time students.

# Student Health Center



- To access the student health portal you must have your Howard University email and password
- Once you have been provided your email address and password log in at [howard.studenthealthportal.com](https://howard.studenthealthportal.com)
- By completing the online immunization form & uploading the required documents to the patient portal, you will speed up the processing of medical holds and the data will go directly into your university medical record

All students are urged to download the form and complete the electronic immunization form and upload supporting documentation to the Pyramed Patient Portal.

## HOW TO NAVIGATE THE PYRAMED PATIENT PORTAL TO FULFILL MEDICAL HOLD REQUIREMENTS

1. Use your Howard University email and password to log in at [howard.studenthealthportal.com](http://howard.studenthealthportal.com)
2. Click on medical Hold, click on **Instructions**. Download, screenshot, or print these instructions.
3. Go back to the **Home Page**, bottom right, and click **Related Links**. Click **Immunization Certificate**, download this form, and take it to your healthcare provider to complete and provide you with supporting documentation.
4. Once you get the form and supporting documentation from your healthcare provider, you are now ready to go back to the patient portal. Click **Forms** complete the online **SHC Immunization Certificate form** and upload the supporting documents.

**HOW TO COMPLETE FORM(S):**

- Go to <https://howard.studenthealthportal.com>. Download your Immunization Certificate and Tuberculosis Screening Forms under "Related Links" for your health care provider to complete.
- Upload completed immunization certificate and tuberculosis screening forms. Once uploaded, fill out the online forms listed on your portal.
- All online forms in the student health portal must be completed in order to have medical holds lifted!**
- Non-Health Science Students 26 years of age & older -** TB screening questionnaire
- If you are unable to provide an immunization record -** Required to submit Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella & Hepatitis B titer lab work to show immunity. Proof of TDAP and Meningitis vaccinations.

Information**

- Positive TB screenings require a TB test
- Insurance Card upload is highly recommended
- Meningococcal after the age of 16 is mandatory for all students living on campus.**

**Immunization Requirements**

<u>Vaccination</u>	<u>Dose Requirement</u>
MMR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2 doses</li> <li>1 dose on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday and 2<sup>nd</sup> at least 4 weeks after 1<sup>st</sup> dose</li> </ul>
Tetanus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tdap or Td within the last 10 years</li> </ul>
Hep B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3 doses</li> <li>2<sup>nd</sup> dose given at least 4 weeks after 1<sup>st</sup> &amp; 3<sup>rd</sup> at least 8 weeks after 2<sup>nd</sup></li> <li>Hep B vaccination series that includes only 2 doses are accepted</li> </ul>
Varicella	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2 doses</li> <li>History of disease-Provide month &amp; year</li> </ul>
Polio (if under the age of 18)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3 doses</li> </ul>
Meningitis ACWY or Men B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 dose required after the age of 16</li> </ul>

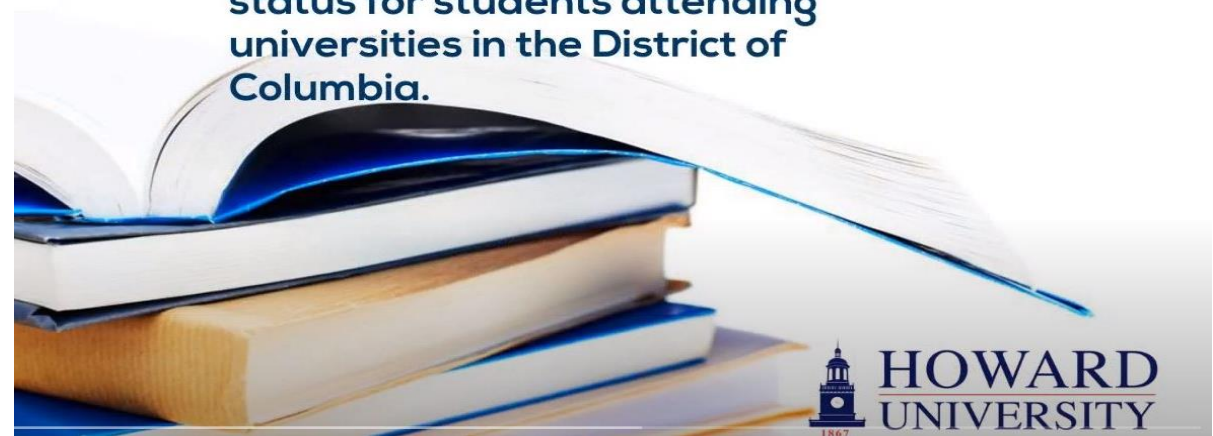




# Student Health Center
